

International Students Conditions of Enrolment

Accommodation

Students must live in approved homestay accommodation.

Attendance

Frequent or unexplained absences must be reported to the New Zealand Immigration Service and this may result in the termination of the students visa. Onehunga High School Policy is a minimum of 85% attendance in all classes (including Tutor), to be eligible to participate in co-curricular (sports, performing arts etc) activities.

School Rules

Students must comply with all school rules. Onehunga High School expects all students to behave in a courteous, responsible way.

Uniform

Students must wear the regulation uniform while attending school.

English Language Proficiency

Students must have a basic level of English Proficiency before entering the school programme.

If a student's entrance test does not meet this requirement a specialised English Language Course will be arranged and they must successfully complete this before starting their chosen programme of study.

Medical and Travel Insurance

All students require Medical and Travel and Fee protection insurance*.

The policies must cover

- Loss of fees through insolvency or cessation of your course
- Travel to and from New Zealand
- Medical treatment in New Zealand

**Insurance can be arranged by the school through the company of your choice.*

Most students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand unless they are

- A resident or citizen of Australia
- A national of the United Kingdom in New Zealand
- The holder of a temporary permit that is valid for two or more years

If you do not belong to one of these special categories and you receive medical treatment, you will be liable for the full costs of that treatment.

Accident Insurance

The Accident Compensation Corporation provides accident insurance for all New Zealand citizens, residents and temporary visitors to New Zealand, but you may still be liable for all other medical and related costs. Further information can be viewed on the ACC website at <http://www.acc.co.nz>
